

## **SOME FACTS AND FIGURES ABOUT HMC SCHOOLS**

### **Schools**

- ❖ 251 schools:
  - 45 (18%) are boys only
  - 3 (1%) are girls only
  - 196 (78%) are co-ed
  - 98 (39%) are day only; the remainder offer boarding in some form

### **Pupils**

- ❖ 199,000 pupils:
  - 40,000 boarders/159,000 day
  - 66,000 girls/133,000 boys
  - 56,000 sixth formers
  - 11,000 from overseas
- ❖ Within the ISC, HMC schools educate:
  - 53% of all 11-15 year olds
  - 62% of all 13-19 year olds
  - 65% of all sixth formers
  - 59% of all boarders
  - 37% of all secondary-aged girls
  - 45% of all sixth form girls

### **Staff**

- ❖ 21 865 staff:
  - 4:3 (men: women)
  - 4,000 part time
  - 9.4:1 pupil: teacher ratio
- ❖ 2,060 new staff (10% turnover):
  - 33% from the independent sector
  - 25% from the maintained sector
  - 13% from ITT (NQTs)
  - 29% "other" (direct entry)
- ❖ 1,838 staff left:
  - 31% to independent schools
  - 10% to maintained schools
  - 59% to somewhere else (including retirement)
- ❖ 3:1 transfer between maintained and independent sectors

## Public examinations

- ❖ At Key Stage 4 in 2010: the 209 HMC schools in England had 22,843 students at the end of Key Stage 4 taking GCSE/IGCSE exams: an average of 109 candidates per school (compare 106 in 2009). Of these students, *at least*:
  - 58% were entered for IGCSE maths and/or English
  - 25% did at least one IGCSE science
  - 87% (19800 students) gained at least one A\*-C in a MFL at GCSE
  
- ❖ At Key Stage 5 in 2010, the 209 HMC schools in England had 22,844 students (an average entry of 109 students per school) in the upper sixth. In addition:
  - the average subject points score was 244.7
  - the average points score per student was 929.8
  - the average number of A level subjects (or equivalent) per student was 3.80
  - 34 HMC schools (16.3%) are in the top 5% of schools and colleges nationally for their KS4 to KS5 Value Added (VA) scores
  - 73 HMC schools (51.2%) are in the top 25% of schools and colleges nationally for their KS4 to KS5 Value Added (VA) scores
